The envelop containing the quotation should bear the superscription, QUOTATION FOR THE SUPPLY OF(Name of Equipment) and should be addressed to the **CHAIRMAN, HDC, ESI HOSPITAL, PARIPPALLY**. Separate Quotations should be submitted for each items ie I, II,& III.

The Earnest Money as shown above should be in favour of ESI Fund Account No. 1 payable at Chathannoor.

Intending tenderers may submit quotation in their own paper. The Quotation complete in all respects along with all the documents must be deposited in the office of the Chairman, HDC, ESI Hospital Parippally on or before 18/02/2009 up to 11 AM. The tenders will be opened at 11 30 AM on the same day in the chamber of the Chairman HDC in the presence of tenderers or their representative who may be present at that time.

Detailed specifications of items listed above are given at the end of the Tender or can be downloaded from the website www.esickerala.gov.in

The contents of the bid should include the following items

- 1) Covering letter including the list of enclosures
- 2) EMD in accordance with instructions as above
- 3) Name and detailed specification of the quoted equipment with prize
- 4) Name and detailed specifications of accessories if any with prize

- 5) Warranty offered Year/s
- 6) Rates of AMC and CAMC for five years after expiry of warranty
- 7) Authority letter from manufacturer/stockiest/authorized distributor if applicable
- 8) User list
- 9) Name and address of the nearest service center
- 10) Catalogue of the Equipment showing the make/ model No. and specification
- 11) Declaration/undertaking on stamp paper as per the proforma enclosed

Rates should preferably be typed in words as well as in figures, free from erasing, cutting, and overwriting. Rates of S.T/ VAT must be quoted separately. The Prize should be all inclusive lump sum prize offered for each item including cost of the equipment, freight, insurance, transit, insurance, packing forwarding etc. and including charges for installation and commissioning with all the men and materials required for the same and included charges for the quoted warranty period.

The prize should be on F.O.R. ESI hospital, Parippally. No other charges in addition will be payable on any account over and above the lump sum prize quoted in the bid. The rates quoted in ambiguous terms such as " Freight on actual basis" or "Taxes as applicable extra" or " Packing forwarding extra" will render the bid liable to rejection.

The Prize should be quoted in INR.

Each and every pages of the quotation be separately numbered and duly signed.

UNDERTAKING: (To be submitted in no judicial stamp paper of Rs. 10/-).

- 1)I.....(Name of authorized signatory) the undersigned hereby declare and affirm that I have gone through the terms and conditions governing the tender and undertake to comply with all terms and conditions.
- 2) That the rates quoted by me are valid and binding upon me for the entire period of contract
- 3) The rates quoted are not higher than quoted for any govt. institution/hospital in India.
- 4) The earnest money of Rs.....deposited by me vide banker cheque/ Demand Draft No.Dateddrawn on(Name of the bank) is attached herewith.
- 5) That I/We authorize the Chairman HDC ESI Hospital Parippally to forfeit the earnest money deposited by me/us if any delay or failure to supply article within the stipulated time and the items of desired/quoted quality.
- 6) That I will be in position to provide Annual Maintenance Contract/ Comprehensive Maintenance contract (AMC/ CAMC) ,Spare parts, accessories attached and its consumables for 6 years from the date of satisfactory installation of the equipment.

7) That there is no vigilance/CBI case or court case pending against the firm, debarring my firm to supply of items quoted

8) That I hereby undertake to supply the items as per the direction given in the supply order within stipulated period.

9) That I undertake to maintain the equipment to the satisfaction of user during the period of warranty and guarantee.

10) I have been informed that the Chairman HDC has the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS GOVERNING CONTRACT

1. The tenderer must enclose a draft/ banker Cheque detailed above as earnest money drawn in favour of ESI Fund A/C No. 1
2. EMD deposited with earlier tender if any will not be adjusted against this tender. Tender without EMD will not be accepted in any case.
3. Tenderer will have to demonstrate the quoted item to Technical Evaluation Committee within the stipulated time frame as and when asked for or as has been mentioned in the tender. The tender shall liable to be cancelled on non-compliance of this clause.
4. EMD will be released after finalization of tender.
5. Successful bidder has to deposit 10% of total cost of the equipment as performance security with the Chairman HDC in the form of Demand Draft / Bankers Cheque, else 10% of the payment due (Rounded -up) shall be with held which will be released on satisfactory performance of the equipment after expiry of warranty.
6. The company will get only one chance for demo. In case the company fails to arrange the demo the tender shall liable to be cancelled.
7. The date of demonstration shall be fixed with mutual consent on telephone the same shall be confirmed in writing. In any case not more than two weeks time shall be given to arrange for demo.
8. In case demo of equipment is required the same has to be arranged at Parippally or nearby town Kollam .
9. Only the items of manufacturers or their authorized distributor/ stockiest would be considered.

10. Tenderer must provide telephone No. for all correspondences.

11. The equipment should be guaranteed/ warranted for a minimum period of one year or as mentioned in specifications the date of satisfactory installation and inspection.

12. Delivery schedule:- within four weeks of placement of supply order.

13. Firm should undertake to enter into Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC/CAMC) for equipment as well as accessories attached, for minimum period of five years after completion of warranty period and accordingly quote the rates of AMC for five years. The rates quoted should be both for Comprehensive AMC as well as Non Comprehensive AMC for five years. Firm should undertake to keep the equipment in running order throughout the year and in case of equipment going out of order, the fault will be attended within 24 hours of lodging the complaint.

14. Payment of equipment will be made within two weeks after the successful installation and satisfactory inspection of the equipment.

15. For equipments where reagents, cartridge, consumables, etc. are required the prize bid must include :A Rate list indicating the prizes and packing prevalent on date of tendering. B List indicating cost and life of consumables.

16. Photocopy of latest Income Tax clearance/PAN No. should be enclosed with the completed tender.

17. Tenderer if not a manufacturer, has to submit manufacturers' authorization certificate

18. The Chairman HDC has the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason (s) thereof.

19. The Tenderer is required to submit an undertaking as per the proforma enclosed on a non judicial stamp paper of Rs.,10/-
